Los Angeles laundry workers to go on unfair labor practice strike

Workers, labor leaders and community allies to rally Thursday, March 2 at 11 a.m.

Los Angeles, CA – On Thursday, March 2, laundry workers at Domestic Uniform Rental in downtown Los Angeles, CA, are going on an unfair labor practice strike. The workers are members of the Western States Regional Joint Board of Workers United, an SEIU affiliate.

“I have spent 14 years doing this difficult work alongside my dedicated coworkers, and Domestic needs to remember that they must respect us and our rights as unionized workers in the workplace,” said Blanca Echeveria, a laundry worker at Domestic Uniform Rental. “The company can't tell us not to talk to our union representatives.”

Workers at Domestic Uniform Rental process linens for car dealerships, restaurants, and other businesses and industries. They do the critical but invisible work of keeping many workplaces clean and safe.
